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

## Pakal Dul Hydroelectric Project (1000MW)

### **1. Brief Introduction of Project**

Pakal Dul (1000MW) HE Project was initially conceived by NHPC and later on got transferred to Chenab Valley Power Projects [P] Limited (CVPPPL). CVPPPL is a Joint Venture Company of NHPC Limited, JKSPDC and PTC (India) Limited incorporated on 13/06/2011 for execution of 03 Hydroelectric Projects namely Pakal Dul, Kiru and Kwar with aggregate installed capacity of 2164 MW at Chenab River Basin in Distt Kishtwar of Jammu & Kashmir, with equity participation of 49%, 49% and 2% by NHPC, JKSPDC & PTC respectively.

Pakal Dul HE Project is proposed on river Marusudar, a tributary of Chenab in district Kishtwar of J&K. The project envisages construction of a 167 m high Dam, 2 nos. of Head Race Tunnel of 7.20M diameter and 10 km length, an underground Power House with 4 units of 250 MW each. The annual energy generation will be 3330 MU.

**Status of Other Clearances**

Clearance from Fisheries Department and clearance from Hydraulic Division (PHE & Irrigation) have been received in the month of February 2016.

NOC from mining department has been obtained on dated 23.02.2017.

**R&R Plan**

The J&K govt. has approved the Rehabilitation and Resettlement plan of the project vide Govt. Order dated 22.02.2017 and 07.03.2019, total payment of Rs 49.09 Cr has been released as on date in favour of Commissioner Rehabilitation and Resettlement, Pakal Dul HEP (DC Kishtwar) for implementation of RR Plan.

Disbursement of RR benefits is in progress and a payment of Rs 37.50 Crores to Project Affected Families (PAFs) has been made so far.

**3. Status of Private Land Acquisition**

Final awards for acquisition of Power House area land and Reservoir area land have been accorded. An amount of Rs 94.77 Crores has already been deposited with the Collectorates for disbursement. Out of this, a total payment of Rs.85.12 Crores (approx.) has been disbursed to land owners comprising Rs.62.00 cr. for Dam Reservoir area and Rs. 23.12 cr. (upto 21/10/2020).for Power House area.

#### 4. Status of Tender/Award

The Hon'ble High Court of J&K pronounced its judgement on **28.01.2017** in favour of CVPP Ltd. wherein cancellation of tenders was upheld. Accordingly, tendering process on Package mode for the Project was taken up in following packages of major works and the present status of the tenders and awarded works is as under;

**Dam Package** : Dam Package awarded to M/s Jai Prakash Associates Ltd on **21.06.2018** along with Diversion Tunnel and HRT from upstream side. The site has been handed over to M/s Jaiprakash Associates Ltd. The status of construction works is as-

**DT Inlet** :DT Inlet Portal Excavation work up to berm at EL 1564.0 m is completed including slope protection upto EL 1568 m. DT day lighted on 27.08.2020. Invert concreting lining progress: 813 m achieved out of length 851 m.

Portal development works for Adit to HRT has been completed. Excavation work of **Adit 1 to HRT-2** has been completed and inserted into HRT-2 on **18.03.2020**.

**Adit-I A to HRT -I**: The cumulative progress till date is 454.5 m, out of total length of 698 m.

**Excavation of HRT-2**: The cumulative progress till date is 250.5 m, out of total length of 2086.708 m.

**Intake Gate Platform**: Excavation along with slope protection upto EL. 1740 m has been completed. PCC work in berm at EL 1740 m is completed. Excavation for 2nd bench upto EL 1721m and 3rd bench upto EL 1706 m is in progress leaving benches for slope Protection Work. Fixing of Chain link fabrics and Shotcreting is in progress from EL 1740 to EL 1730 m.

**Tunnel Spillway Gate Shaft Platform**:-Excavation

upto EL. 1709 m has been completed. Rock anchors & Shotcrete is in Progress.

**Surface Spillway:** - Excavation for first bench at EL. 1738 m upto section 11-11 has been completed. Further excavation for first bench from section 11-11 to 15-15 is in progress. Excavation for next bench at EL 1723 is under progress. Slope Protection above EL 1738m is under progress

Approach road works are in progress at various locations i.e. DT Inlet road, DT Outlet road and Dam top road. Formation Cutting in DT inlet Road has been completed and road has been made through for Vehicular Movement, re-grading & protection work is in Progress. DT outlet Road completed 1086 m against the anticipated length of 1400m. Dam Top Road completed 245 m out of anticipated length of 300m.

Approach road works to Adit-I to HRT-II has been completed.

Approach road works to the Tunnel Spillway are in progress and out of 240 m length of road formation cutting of 158 m length has been completed.
