



Also, he emphasized on the need of carrying out the construction work of Dulhasti Stage-II through central sector by NHPC on the basis of expertise and readily availability of competent & skilled human resource and basic infrastructures etc. The MoS was apprised that the Intake structure of Stage-II which was constructed by NHPC is already with Dulhasti Power Station and presently being looked after and controlled by Dulhasti PS. The discussions were held in the presence of local MLA and MoS (Independent Charge) Govt. of J&K, Sh. Sunil Kumar Sharma and Shri MS Babu, Managing Director, CVPPP. The detailed discussions and bottlenecks in respect of the Power Projects of CVPPP including start of Pakal Dul HEP by Joint Venture were also discussed by Shri MS Babu, MD.





